After School Homework Help Guidelines

- The purpose of the after school homework program is to provide students with a quiet place where they can work to complete their homework assignments and ask for help as needed. A supervisor may not always be able to work one on one with a student for extended periods.
- Attendance is taken at 3:30pm. You are expected to be in the library at this time.
- From 3:40-4:20 is QUIET work time on your homework or missing assignments.
- Only one student per table or work space. Seating will be assigned if needed.
- Small groups may be formed if and only when students are all working on the same assignment.
- You are welcome to bring snacks from home. There will be no garbage or mess left at the end of tutoring. If there are problems with this snacks will not be allowed.
- Be sure to **bring everything** you need to complete your work (pens, pencils, markers, chromebook, notebooks, worksheets, binders, calculators, etc).
- AUP violations can and will be handed out during tutoring if you are using your computer for games or other unapproved reasons.
- If you are doing anything disruptive that makes it difficult for other students to complete their work you will be asked to leave, detentions will be issued, and your parents will be notified.
