

Crivitz School District COVID procedures

Effective 9/22/21

The District will be utilizing the Wisconsin Department of Health Services COVID-19 symptoms guidance in determining whether a student/staff member will be sent home from school. That symptom list is as follows:

- Either singly a cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new loss of smell or taste, vomiting, fever of 100.4 or greater

OR

- At least two of the following symptoms: fever (measured or subjective) of less than 100.4, chills or rigors myalgia (muscle aches), headache, sore throat, fatigue, muscle or body aches, congestion or runny nose, nausea, diarrhea.

*Students displaying these symptoms will be sent home with a recommendation (not required) that they are tested for COVID-19. Students may return to school after a 10-day isolation with the onset of symptoms being day zero or a negative COVID test.

Unvaccinated students identified as close contacts to a positive COVID-19 case must quarantine (and not attend school or school functions) for 10 days with the date of last exposure being day zero.

- Early re-entry is possible if the student remains symptom-free and receives a negative PCR COVID test taken on or after day 6 of their quarantine.
- Proof of this test is required upon return to school.
- Close contacts that become symptomatic must remain out of school for 10 school days with the onset of symptoms being day zero unless they received a negative COVID test.

Unvaccinated household contacts of a positive COVID-19 case must quarantine for 10 days starting with the onset of symptoms of the positive case.

- There is no option to return early.

Vaccinated students identified as close contact to a positive COVID-19 case, household or other, do not need to quarantine.
